

## Waiver of English Proficiency Test

---

Applicants who are unable to provide a TOEFL or IELTS score may provide other test scores of equal level or the following:

1. An evaluation from a language instructor specifying the number of hours of English language instruction per week;
2. A statement from the education institute stating that the medium of instruction is completely or mainly in English (specify how much percentage);
3. Other supporting documents which state that the applicant's English proficiency is higher than or equivalent to our minimum requirement:

**TOEFL PBT 500 / CBT 173 / iBT 73 or IELTS 5.5**

4. A statement claiming any of the following, accompanied by detailed explanation:
  - being a native-speaker of English;
  - having already obtained a first degree (bachelors) or higher in an English speaking country;
  - having lived in a country where English is an official language (how many years);

The above-mentioned documents should preferably be printed on school letterhead and signed by a faculty member or the registrar.

**Please note, however, all such materials will be subject to the review committee of the department/institute to decide whether they will consider these supporting documents in place of TOEFL/IELTS/TOEIC test results. The orientation institution reserves the right to require admitted students to undergo a further English proficiency test after arriving in Taiwan.**
